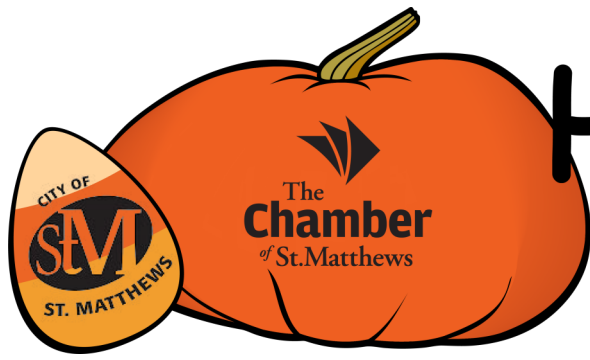
In an effort to be as inclusive as possible we encourage every vendor to not only provide sweet eats, but also be a **Teal Pumpkin**. This project is designed to offer non-food treats for trick-or-treaters who may suffer from a food allergy. Included in this packet is a Teal Pumpkin Project sign for your booth as well as a bit more information about the project.



The event will start at 11 AM so we suggest vendors arrive between 9 and 10 AM as kids begin to line up *early*. We will have teams available with golf carts to get your booths set up and again at tear down as parking is not near the event. A packet of information detailing booth location and parking details will come out closer to the event for people that register.

Important things to consider are that your booths will be on grass and sometimes uneven terrain to keep the concrete paths accessible for wheelchairs, strollers, etc. We also do **not** provide tables, chairs or tents, so you'll need to bring your own. We suggest at least two people for every booth as the crowds can be very thick at times. We also request that mascots and the like **not** stay in your booth, but instead work the crowd at the front of the event as to not bog down the line so every kid can get through. There also is no electricity inside the park available for that day so we suggest everything be either battery operated or not have any power requirements.

No signups or sales are allowed on the path.
